The Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) course is sponsored by the National Association of EMTs (NAEMT) and endorsed by the National Association of EMS Physicians (NAEMSP). It is the first course that addresses the most common medical complaints and offers a "think outside the box" method of assessing and managing a patient in medical crisis. The course emphasizes using the scene size-up, history and physical exam to systematically rule-out and rule-in possibilities and probabilities of their medical problem. This course offers the opportunity to be in an assessment-based approach and progress to a diagnostic-based approach to develop a specific treatment plan for a specific medical condition; resulting in a differential diagnosis.

EMS Safety

Taking safety to the streets

Saturday, March 10, 2012

8 am – 5 pm

Emergency Medical Services is a dangerous job. To help promote a culture of EMS safety and to help reduce the number and intensity of injuries incurred by EMS practitioners in carrying out their work, The **National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT)** has introduced the EMS Safety course. EMS Safety is the first national and most comprehensive education program of its kind that teaches techniques on how to best achieve safety on the job.

The EMS Safety Curriculum

The course charges students to become leaders in creating a culture of safety within EMS and identifies steps they can take to be a part of the process. The curriculum covers the following:

Crew resource management — Adapts airline industry concept of a “sterile cockpit” to ambulance cab and patient compartments, stressing clear communications and situational awareness.

Emergency vehicle safety — Reviews principles of defensive driving, ambulance design dangers, use of warning lights and sirens and risk mitigation techniques.

Responsibilities in scene operations — Addresses roadside safety, apparatus, lighting, high-visibility clothing, and interagency planning and cooperation, giving students the opportunity to describe how they would protect the scene in a series of simulated incidents.

Patient handling — Covers body mechanics and safe moving of patients using proper lifting techniques and mechanical and other transfer aids, strategies to avoid common back injuries, the “EGGS” methodology, proper evaluation, planning and preparation for patients and the environment, and equipment selection and use.

Patient, practitioner and bystander safety — Discusses crime scenes and dangerous facilities, commonly improvised weapons, techniques of verbal de-escalation and restraints.

Personal health — Outlines the importance of personal health.

Geriatric Education For Emergency Medical Services (GEMS)

Basic and Advanced Provider Course

Wednesdays, February 8 and 15, 2012 (8AM - 2PM)

The American Geriatrics Society (AGS) and the National Council of State EMS Training Coordinators (NCSEMSTC) have developed the Geriatric Education for Emergency Medical Services (GEMS) Program, a national continuing education curriculum. This program was designed specifically for First Responders, EMTs, Paramedics, and any other emergency care provider.

What does GEMS Cover?

GEMS represents the most credible and complete source of prehospital medical information on older adults. It addresses all of the special needs of the older population, including the geriatric objectives as identified in the EMT-Basic, Intermediate and Paramedic National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) National Standard Curricula. It also meets and exceeds the New York State CME-based Recertification requirements of a minimum of three (3) hours of continuing education in Geriatrics.

GEMS Students will learn through:

- **Case-Based Lectures** in which providers think about how they would treat a similar case. The lectures cover Aging; Communicating with Older People and Their Caregivers; Assessment of the Older Patient; End-of-Life Care Issues; Trauma, Musculoskeletal Disorders and Falls; Neurological Emergencies and Altered Mental Status; Respiratory and Cardiovascular Emergencies; and other lectures relevant to the older population.
- **Live Action Video** containing real-life footage from the field. These video clips illustrate skills covered in the GEMS Course including Communication and Assessment, Immobilization and Intravenous Therapy.
- **Hands-on Skill Stations** where providers may practice what they learn by reading the textbooks, listening to the lectures and watching the live action video.
- **Small Group Scenarios** in which providers apply information from all aspects of the GEMS Course. The scenarios cover topics such as Communication Challenges, Do Not Resuscitate Orders, Stroke, Medication Interactions, Elder Abuse and Neglect, and Delirium vs. Dementia.

Course lectures and interactive sessions address assessment; airway, breathing and circulation; understanding and caring for children; hypoperfusion; cardiac emergencies and congenital cardiac defects, common medical emergencies, trauma, newborn resuscitation, vascular access, care team management, spinal motion restriction, children with special health-care needs, identification of life threats, scene choreography, transport decisions, and child abuse.

Basic and Advanced Prehospital Trauma Life Support

The Prehospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) course is a unique continuing education program created in recognition of the real need in EMS education for additional training in the handling of trauma patients. This indispensable program is designed to enhance and increase knowledge and skills in delivering trauma care in the prehospital environment.

What does PHTLS Cover?

PHTLS picks up where other educational programs leave off. The course focuses on trauma patients in the prehospital environment - how to identify, stabilize, treat, and transport them with the highest level of care and give them the greatest chance for survival.

This course was developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) in cooperation with The Committee on Trauma of the American College of Surgeons.

PREREQUISITES: Students must be current CFR, EMT, AEMT or Paramedic.
